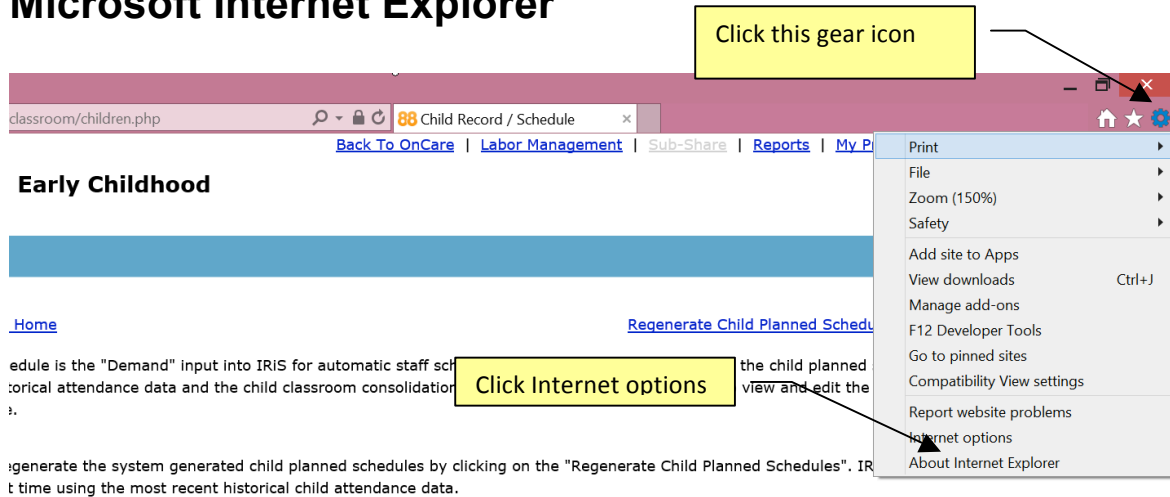

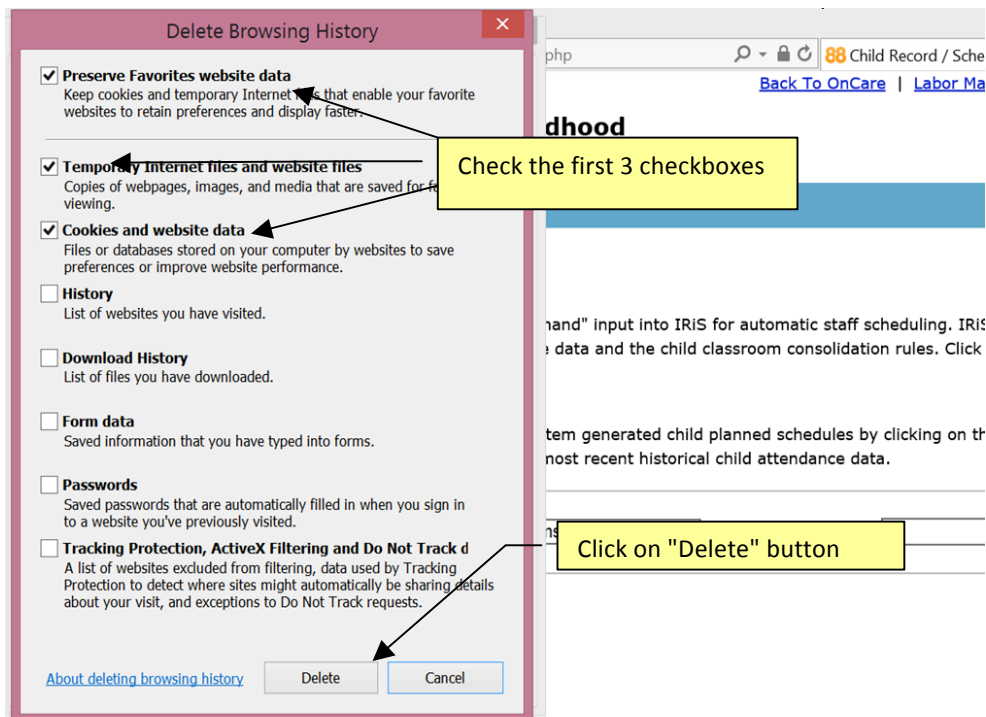
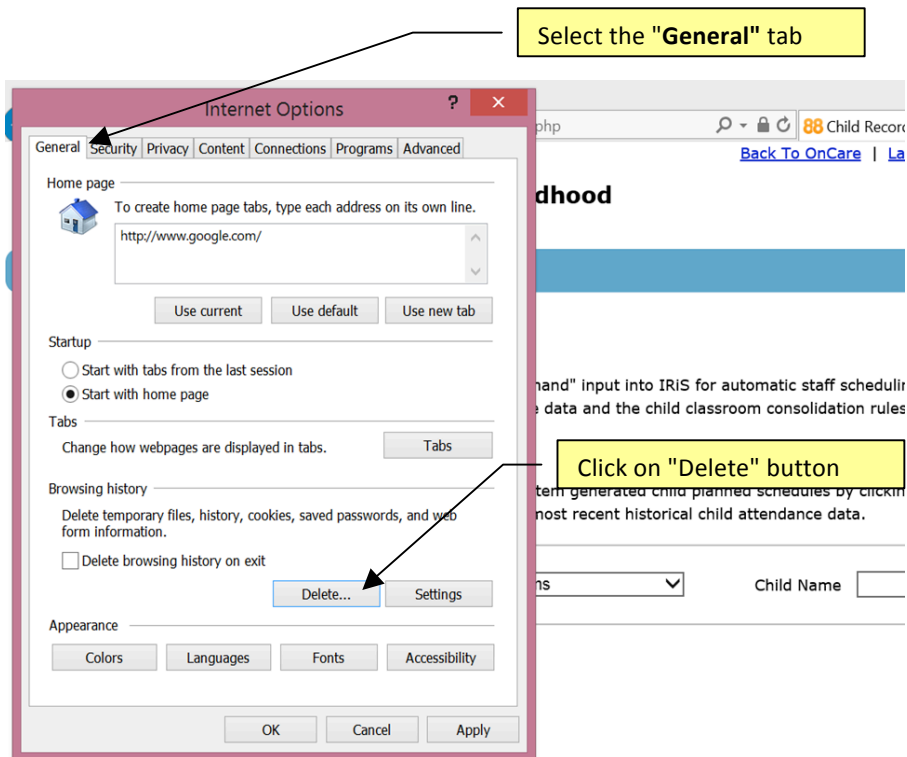
# 1. What is The Purpose

OnCare/Staff88 are both online applications that use the web browser's cookies and cache for optimal performance. Often when we update the application on the server side, the users need to refresh the client's side browser's cookies and cache for the online application to work properly. The following are the steps to refresh the browser's cookies and cache for the 3 major browsers on a PC:

- Microsoft Internet Explorer
- Mozilla Firefox
- Google Chrome

## 2. Microsoft Internet Explorer

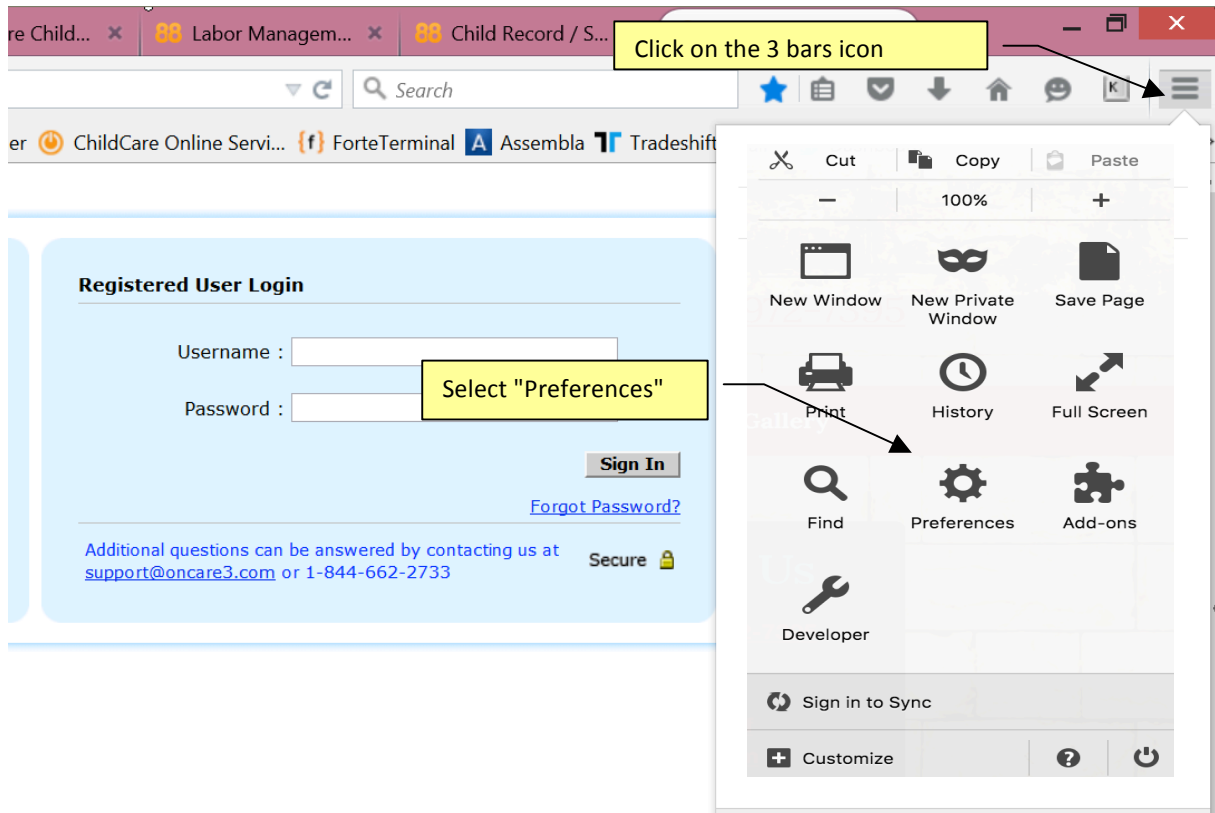


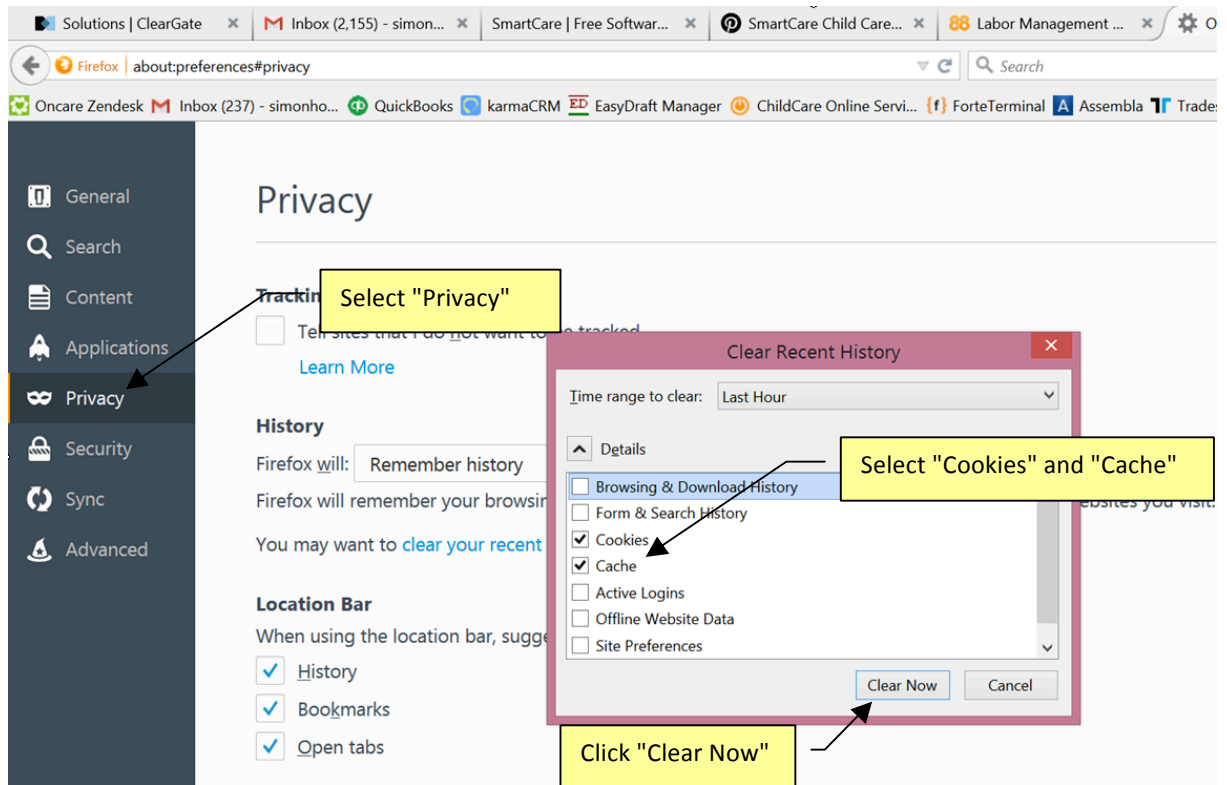

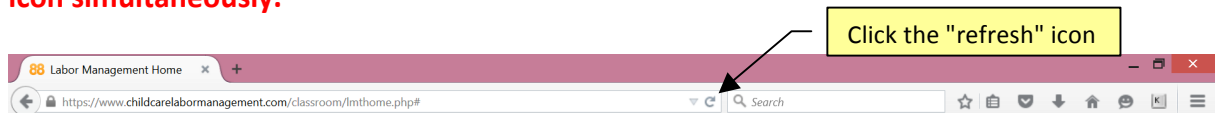


### 3. Mozilla Firefox

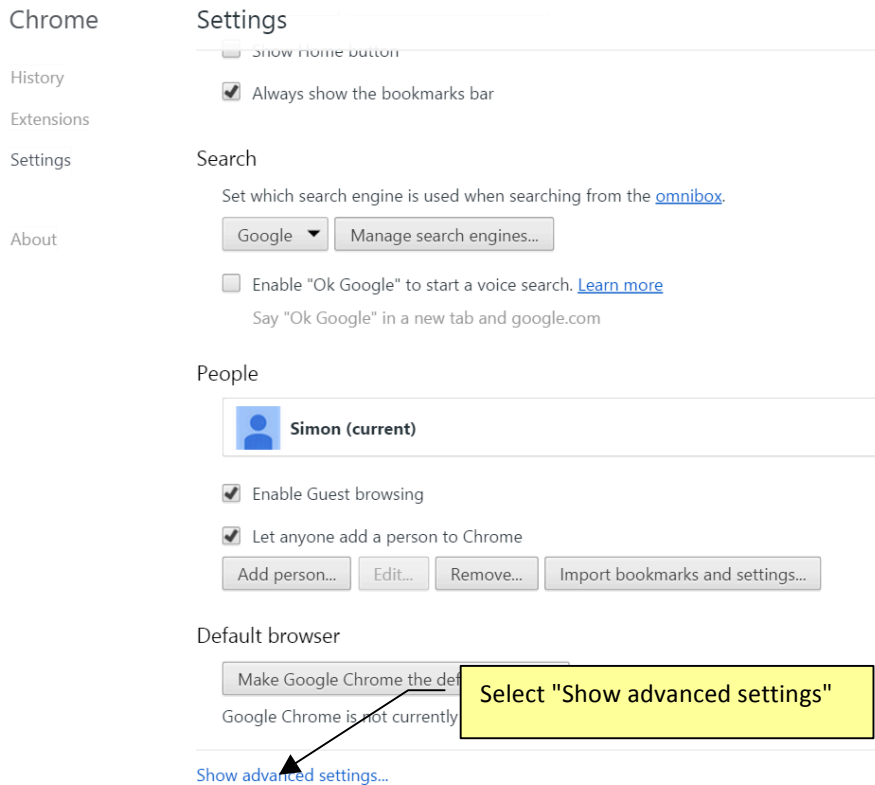
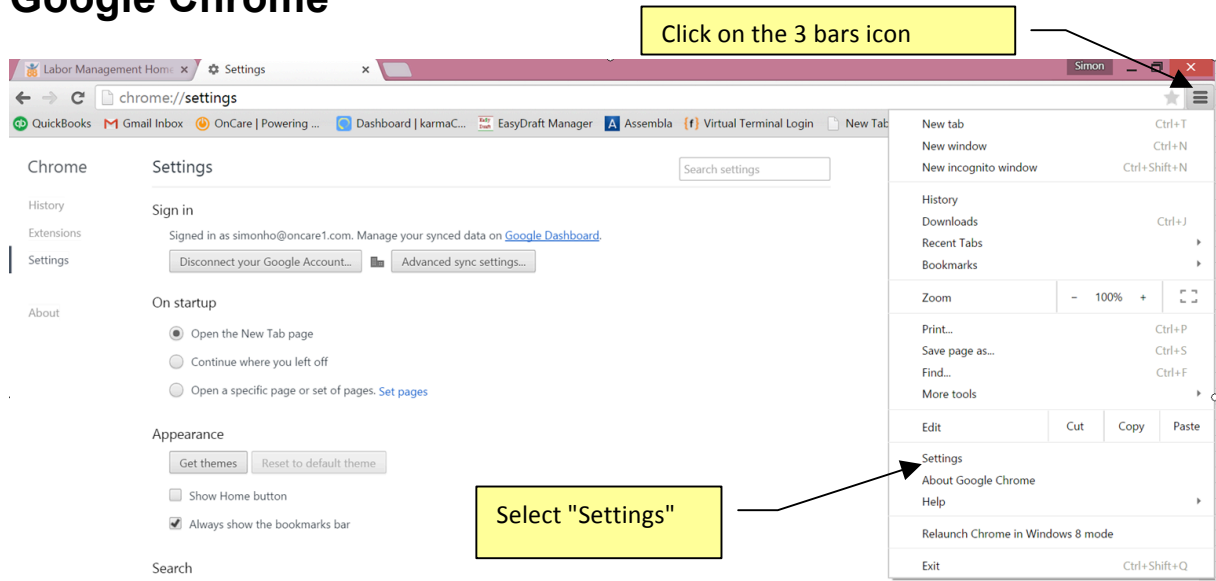


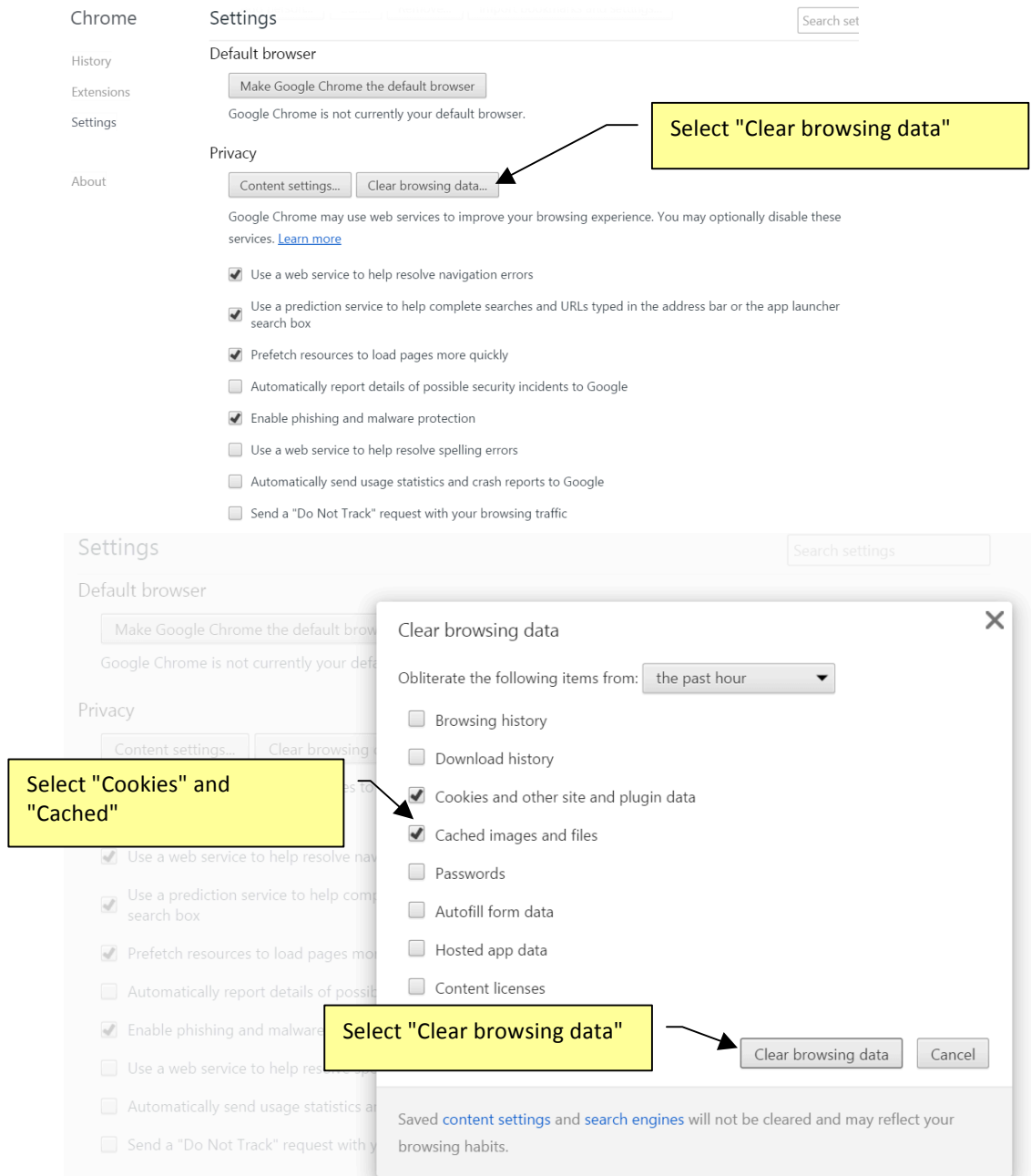
